



Almighty God, our heavenly Father, Your mercies are new every morning; and though we deserve only punishment, You receive us as Your children and provide for all our needs of body and soul. Grant that we may heartily acknowledge Your merciful goodness, give thanks for all Your benefits, and serve You in willing obedience; through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.



Old Testament Lesson:

Numbers 21:4-9...Grumbling and impatience deserve God's punishment, but trust in his Word of mercy and promise leads to salvation.

From Mount Hor they set out by the way to the Red Sea, to go around the land of Edom. And the people became impatient on the way. And the people spoke against God and against Moses, "Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? For there is no food and no water, and we loathe this worthless food."

Then the LORD sent fiery serpents among the people, and they bit the people, so that many people of Israel died. And the people came to Moses and said, "We have sinned, for we have spoken against the LORD and against you. Pray to the LORD, that he take away the serpents from us." So Moses prayed for the people.

And the LORD said to Moses, "Make a fiery serpent and set it on a pole, and everyone who is bitten, when he sees it, shall live." So Moses made a bronze serpent and set it on a pole. And if a serpent bit anyone, he would look at the bronze serpent and live.

Gospel Lesson:

P: The Epistle lesson is recorded in Ephesians 2:4-10.



Saved entirely by God's grace alone, we are now his workmanship eager to carry out the good works he has planned for us.

But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, even when were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved—and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, so that in the coming ages he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

Sermon: John 3:14-21

"And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life.

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God. For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his works should be exposed. CLC Financial Report - February

- General Fund February receipts: \$69,641 VS disbursements: \$80,141. The General Fund subsidizes the work of the Boards of Missions, Trustees, EdPub, & Regents (including ILC.)
- ILC Operations February receipts: \$164,264 VS disbursements: \$126,813.
- IIF February receipts: \$2,858 VS disbursements: None.
- ILC Building Projects February receipts: \$9,405 (including a \$5,076 increase in market value of investments) VS disbursements: None.
- MDF February receipts: \$11,604 VS disbursements: \$10,678.
- Kinship February receipts: \$29,175 VS disbursements: \$2,448.
- CEF February receipts: \$34,642 (including a \$14,391 increase in market value of investments) VS disbursements: \$79,913 (mostly payments on member loans to the CEF).
- SAF February receipts: \$6,098 VS disbursements: \$10,510 (including student loans, grants, scholarships and tuition assistance).
- Reserve Fund is currently invested in a money market account until needed, typically each fiscal yearend.
- EduK8 Fund February receipts: \$5,916. Balance \$43,025.
