This is a service of meditation and silence, commemorating what is the most solemn day of the church year. We will hear Isaiah's prophecy of the suffering Servant and the account of the passion of our Lord. At the end of the service pause to reflect on the unsurpassed, divine love which caused the Son of God to sacrifice Himself for us.
