
First lesson:

Acts 4:23-33...No matter how great the opposition and intense the persecution, the Lord's saving will is accomplished.

When they were released, they went to their friends and reported what the chief priests and the elders had said to them. And when they heard it, they lifted their voices together to God and said, “Sovereign Lord, who made the heaven and the earth and the sea and everything in them, who through the mouth of our father David, your servant, said by the Holy Spirit, ““Why did the Gentiles rage, and the peoples plot in vain? The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers were gathered together, against the Lord and against his Anointed’—for truly in this city there were gathered together against your holy servant Jesus, whom you anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, along with the Gentiles and the people of Israel, to do whatever your hand and your plan had predestined to take place. And now, Lord, look upon their threats and grant to your servants to continue to speak your word with all boldness, while you stretch out your hand to heal, and signs and wonders are performed through the name of your holy servant Jesus.”

Sermon: John 10:11-18

I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. He who is a hired hand and not a shepherd, who does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and flees, and the wolf snatches them and scatters them. He flees because he is a hired hand and cares nothing for the sheep.

I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I lay down my life for the sheep. And I have other sheep that are not of this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. So there will be one flock, and one shepherd. For this reason the Father loves me, because I lay down my life that I may take it up again. Council notes

Finances: Offerings for March were \$187 over budgeted needs, and the balance of available funds decreased by \$977, due partially to a large insurance premium paid. Offerings for the fiscal year are \$27,730 below budgeted needs, and the balance of available funds has decreased by \$9,680. It is very encouraging to note that in recent weeks, offerings for the most part have been keeping pace with the budget. May the Lord continue to graciously supply all we need to carry out his work.
