
### New Testament Reading: Luke 24:44-53 NKJV

Then He said to them, "These *are* the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and *the* Prophets and *the* Psalms concerning Me." And He opened their understanding, that they might comprehend the Scriptures.


### Sermon: 2 Corinthians 4:5-7 NKJV
