


## Sermon Theme: Jesus is the King of Truth





Advent Worship Services beginning on **Wed. Dec. 4<sup>th</sup> @ 6:30pm.** Our series this year will be entitled: "His Name Shall Be Called." During the season of Advent, we prepare to celebrate the birth of God's Son, who was given the name *Jesus*—a Hebrew name that means "Jehovah saves." In addition to His earthly name, Holy Scripture calls Jesus by various titles which describe something about His person or work. -Treasurer Caleb Gerbitz advised that the current report shows a surplus of \$11,000, but this will mostly disappear in the next report due to reimbursement of Pastor's moving costs, parsonage repairs, and other expenses.

### Board of Property Report -

-BoP Chairman James Schaser reported that the board has created the internal position of Facilities Manager to coordinate maintenance items, and that Jordan Albrecht is serving in this role.

-The Board of Property has set up a new centralized email address for use in bringing issues to the board's attention: <u>Property@messiahhc.org</u>

-Those who assisted with projects at the parsonage during the six weeks of vacancy were thanked.

-The next report will include the total cost of parsonage updates.

-Parsonage well issues - James clarified that the school is already using city water, but the parsonage is not. The initial connection cost for the parsonage would be around \$2,000 plus distribution plumbing from the existing lateral. A rough estimate is \$6,000 for the connection versus \$10,000 to \$15,000 for a replacement well system. James advised that the well is as old as the house (installed in 1968) but the pump was replaced more recently. The existing particulate filter has been observed to be badly rusted.

-James advised that the congregation wait to make a decision on the parsonage water until the costs of other parsonage updates are reflected in the major project fund. Replacement of the school's rooftop units is another large potential cost item that may come up in the next several years.

### Unfinished Business –

An audit of financial records for Fiscal Year 23/24 was completed by Sam Lisak and John Mueller. Records were found to be in order and accurate.

### New Business –

-Financial Secretary-Carol Gescheidle was approved as Financial Secretary for calendar year 2025. -2025 Church Calendar was approved as presented.

-Video Streaming Honorarium – It was suggested by one of the voters involved with streaming the services that the \$20 weekly honorarium provided for running service livestreams, while appreciated, is no longer necessary. The church secretary now creates the slideshows for services, significantly reducing the amount of work done by videographers. A motion was made, seconded, and carried to eliminate the \$20 videography honorarium.

The next quarterly meeting is scheduled for January 26, 2025.
